Regular Board Meeting Minutes

BOARD ATTENDING: Chairman Dave Bjorneberg, Joe Ratto, and Brian Stephenson, and people from the community were present at the Hansen Elementary Gymnasium.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman, Dave Bjorneberg.

APPROVE AMENDED AGENDA:

Joe Ratto seconded, motion passed unanimously.

- **B.** Principal's Report: Mrs. Skinner said that they are excited about summer school next week. They have around 50 kids attending.

Mrs. Kelly said that the summer sports teams have been playing games this summer and doing very well. We have all of our teachers hired for this year.

C. Superintendent's Report: Superintendent Carson gave a summary of how Federal budgets and funding works.

Heating and Cooling System at elementary: There is no update at this time.

High School Gym wall: We are working on getting another contractor if the other contractor can't get to it.

IHSAA: They have sent out a framework for how schools can compete this year regarding athletic events.

A. Advisory Committee Update: Superintendent Carson gave an update on what they discussed at the meeting. They looked at what this fall may look like. They wanted to know what parents will need to know.

- B. Fall Re-Entry Plan: Mr. Carson went over the draft as a possible COVID protocol. They discussed it in the administration meeting last week and prepared the draft. Joe Ratto made a motion to approve the 2020-21 School Operational COVID Protocol. Brian Stephenson seconded, motion passed unanimously. Joe Ratto made a motion that we will intend to start school, up to the yellow level unless conditions drastically change. Seconded by Brian Stephenson, motion passed unanimously. The board will schedule a special meeting on July 3rd at 7:00 pm in the elementary gym to evaluate the pandemic conditions.
- C. Legal Services: Superintendent Carson explained that the current attorney that we have been working with will be opening up a new practice. Superintendent Carson wanted to know if the board would like to stick with our current law firm or follow the attorney that we have been working with. He talked about the price difference of each firm. Joe Ratto made a motion to enter into a contract with Holinka Law P.C. Brian Stephenson seconded, motion passed unanimously.
